McLane Advanced Technologies will support Department of the Army's Movement Tracking Systems (MTS)

Temple, TX – McLane Advanced Technologies – in collaboration with the prime SAWTST, LLC – will provide software support services to the Department of the Army for its Moving Tracking System (MTS). The total SAWTST-MAT contract effort if all options are exercised is valued at \$3.4 million starting June 21, 2010 for a period of two years.

MTS is a transportation specific logistics system that provides the communications and tracking necessary for Common User Logistics Transport (CULT) vehicles and other select Combat Service Support (CSS) assets to complete their distribution missions on the digitized battlefield. As such, it is critical that the packaging and distribution of MTS be handled in a manner that provides units with up to date logistics and post deployment support for MTS software. Through this contract, SAWTST-MAT will support MTS in configuration management, software package development, training and testing.

“We are very excited to help perform this critical global logistics program in support of the U.S. Army,” said MAT Chief Executive Officer David Mitchell. “Logistics systems of this nature give today’s Warfighter the preparation, flexibility and readiness needed to defend our country’s freedom.”
