MAT Wins Texas A&M University Contract

McLane Advanced Technologies recently was awarded a Website and Application Development contract for Texas A&M University in Bryan - College Station

TEMPLE, TEXAS.

McLane Advanced Technologies was awarded a Master Services Agreement on June 6, 2007 from Texas A&M University's Finance Division Computing Group (FDCG). Under this type of agreement, the FDCG sends purchase orders when website and application development work is needed. Although the Finance Division has a small IT staff on-site, they indicated a need to outsource large projects and overflow work to an outside company. Since a Master Service Agreement doesn't have a specified award value, (FDCG) departments can submit purchase orders to McLane Advanced Technologies within the Finance Division. This could lead to a significant amount of work for the Temple based company.

MAT placed first out of 17 companies who submitted proposals to A&M. The second place company, an IT company from California, also won the contract. This is not the first contract for an Institute of Higher Learning however. MAT is already doing development work for Central Texas College in Distance Learning. It is however, the first multi-year contract with a University of significant size.
